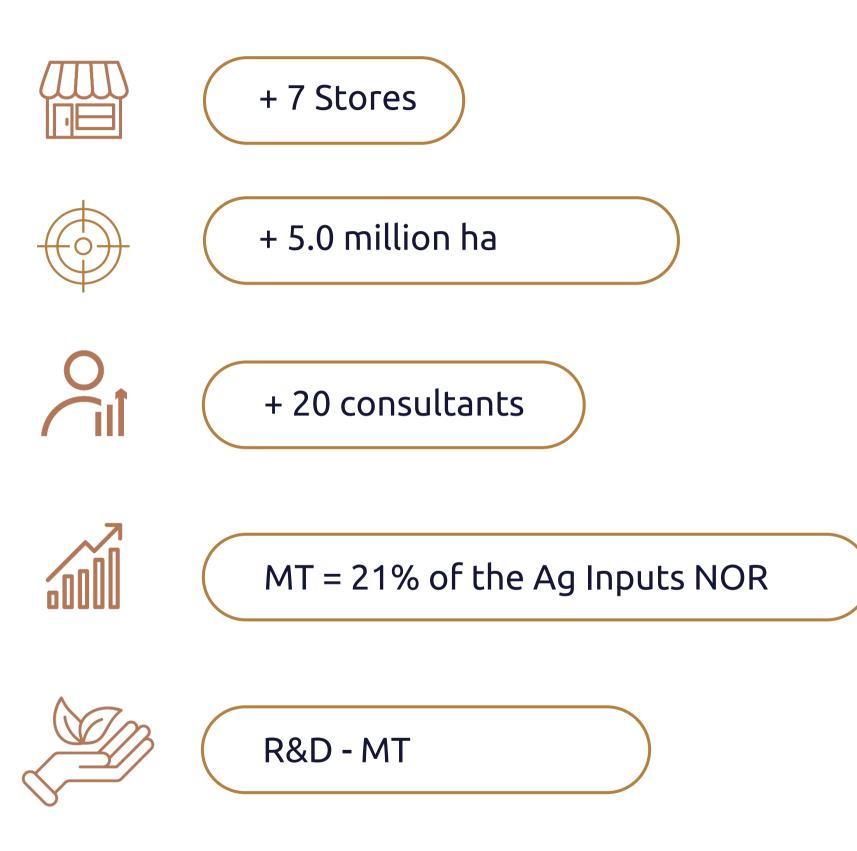

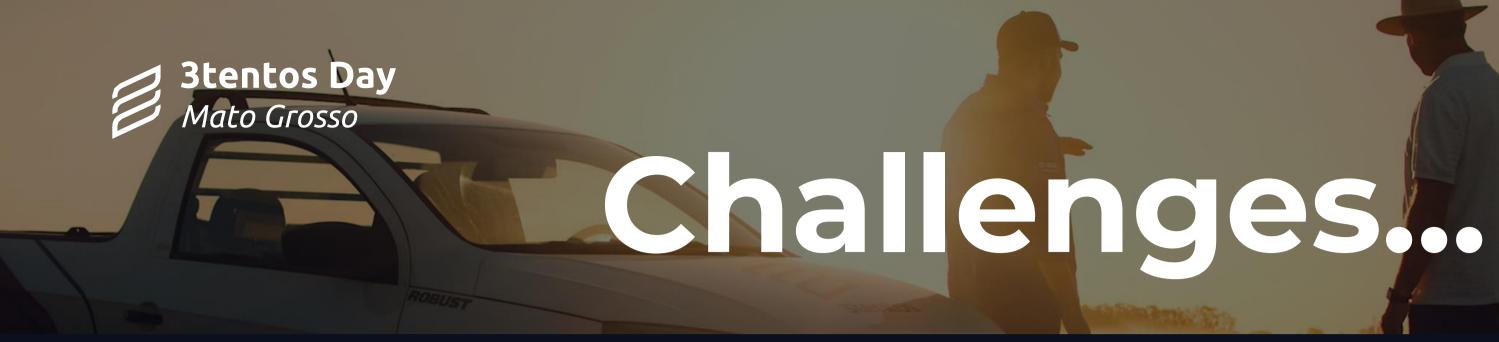

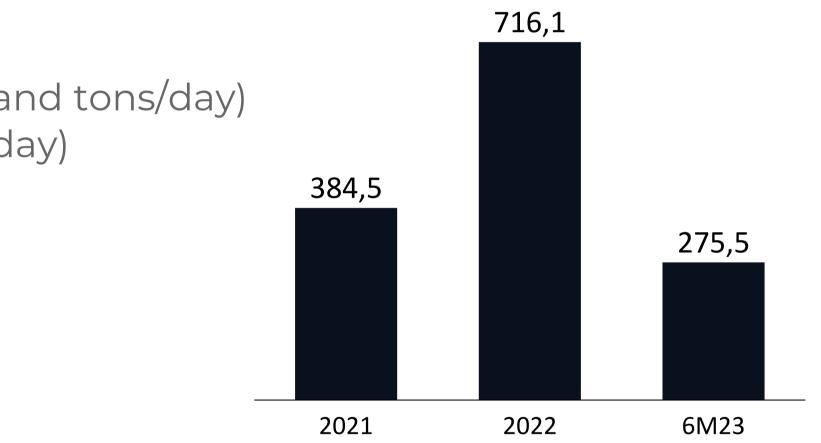

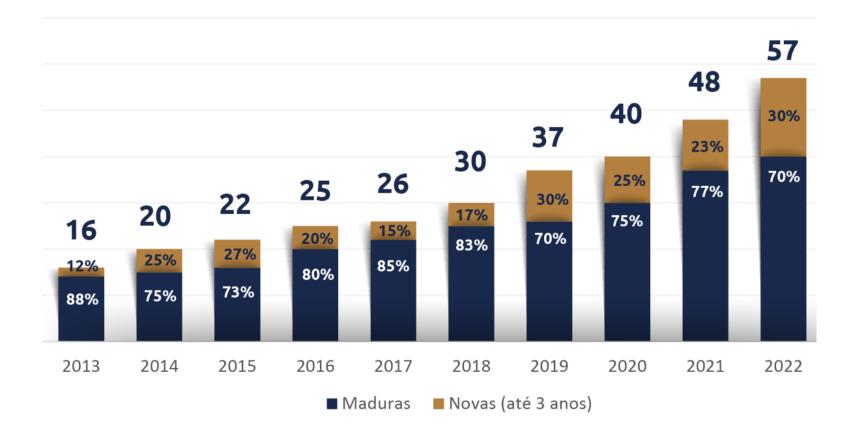

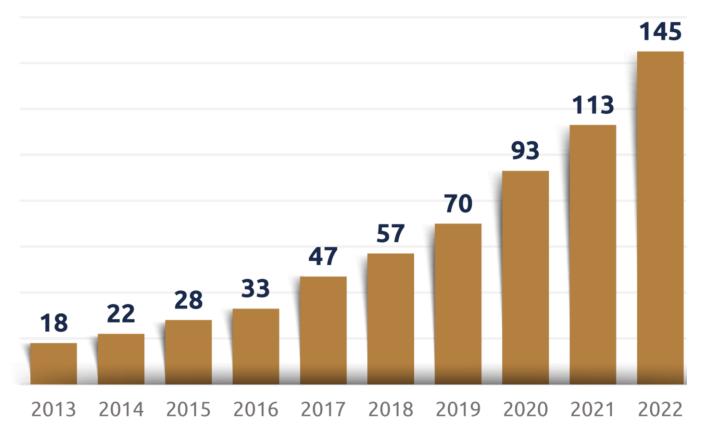

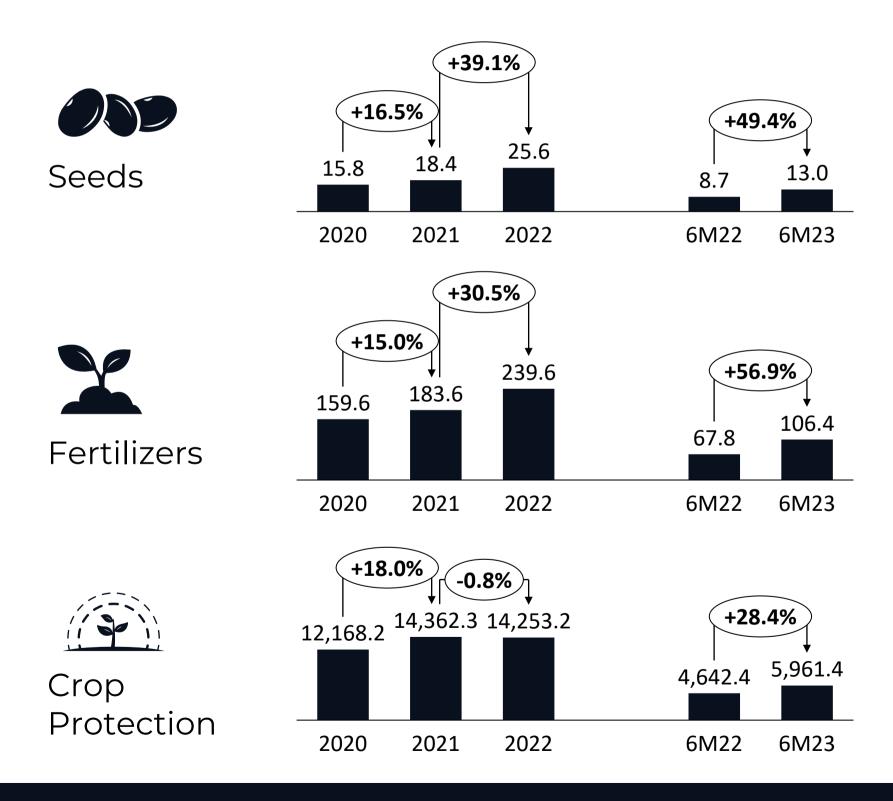

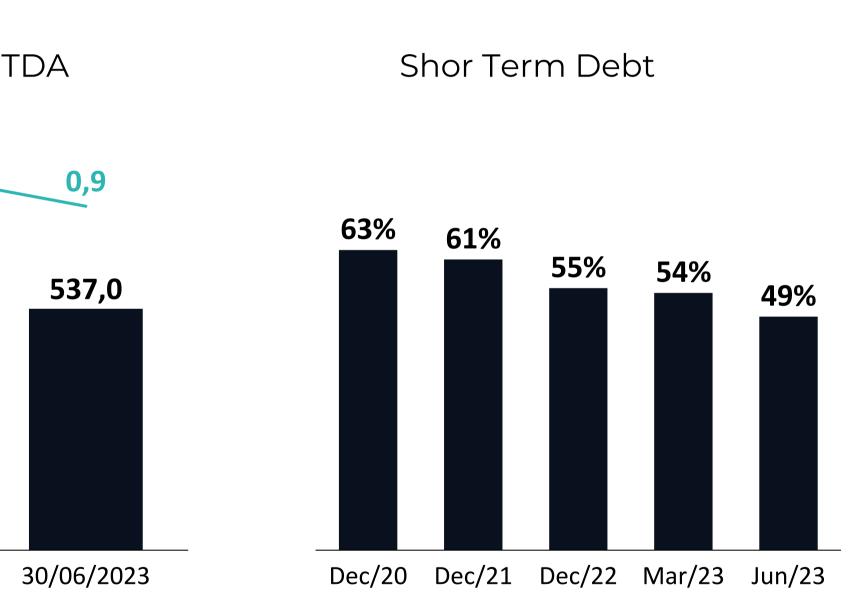

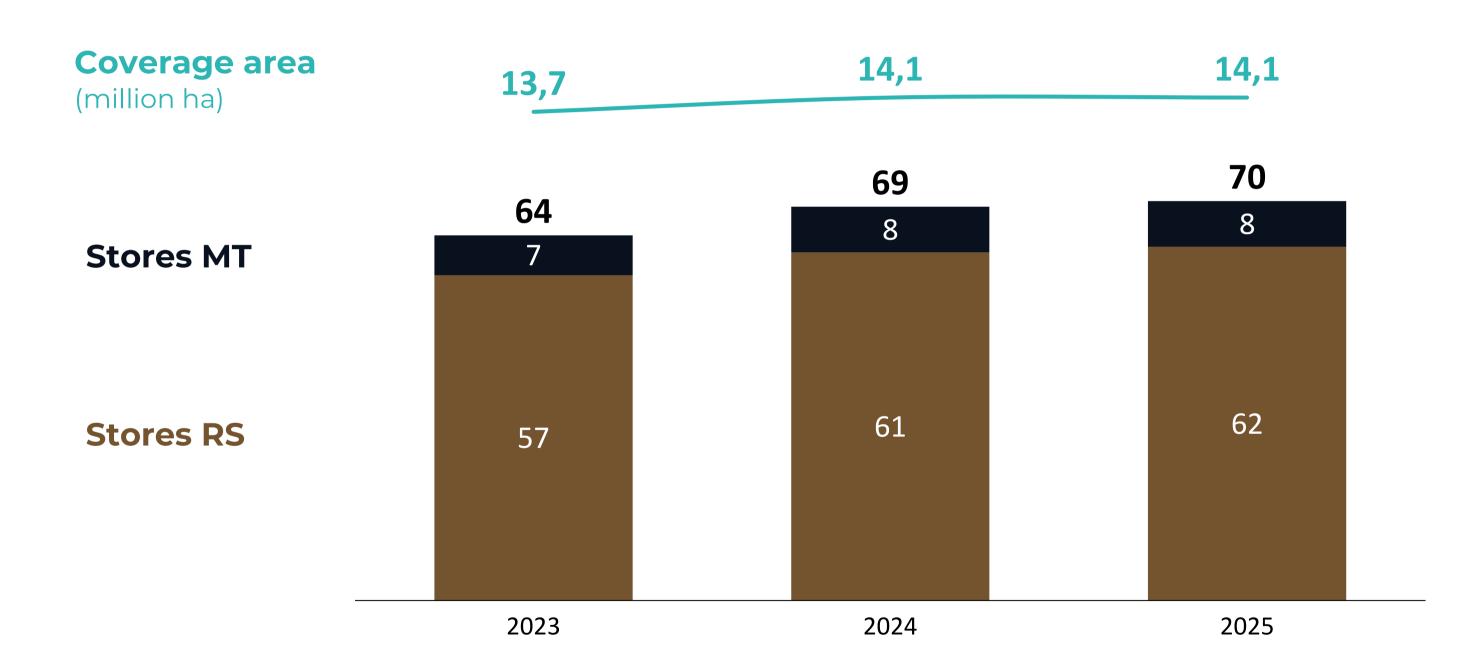


- Net Debt / EBITDA Net Debt (R\$ million)





Stores and coverage area evolution



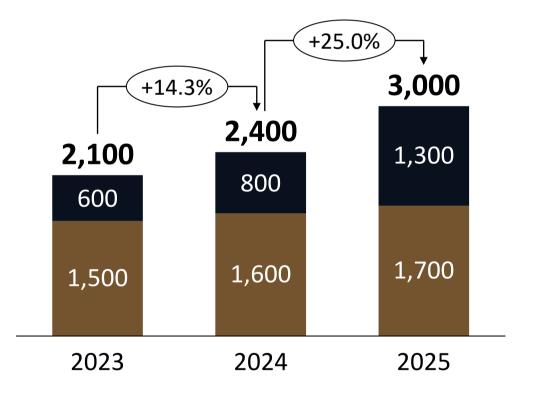


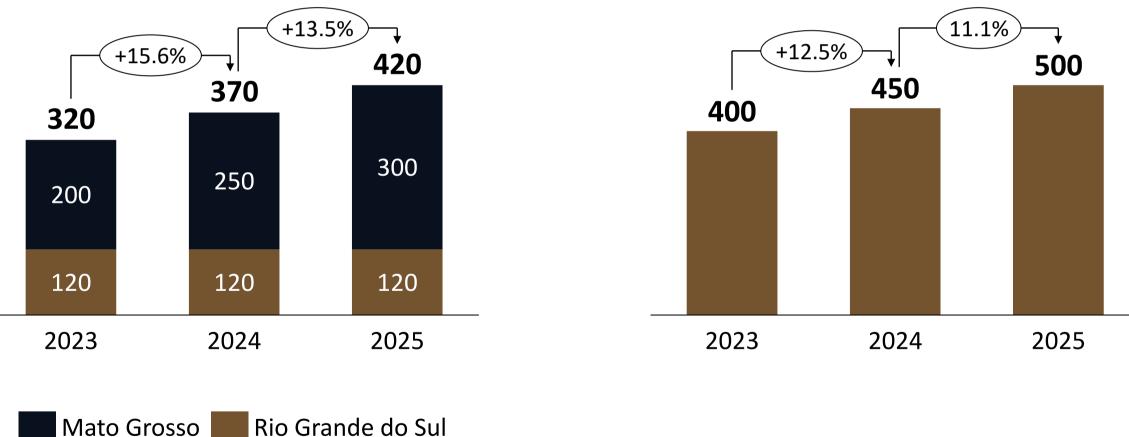

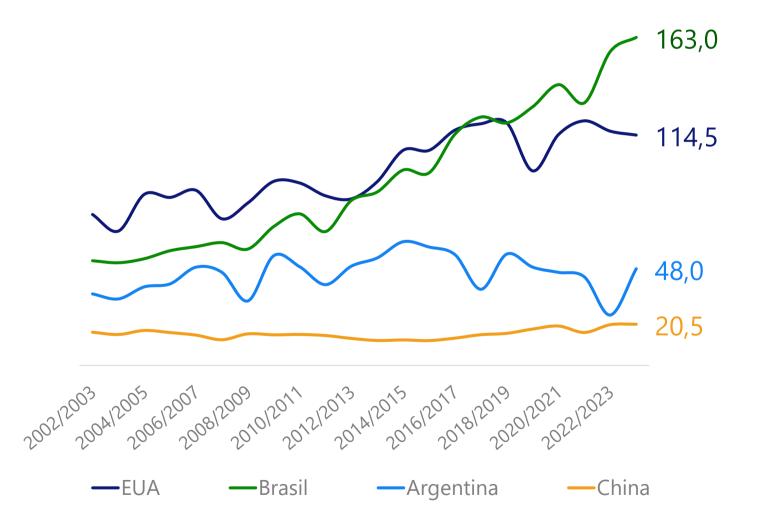

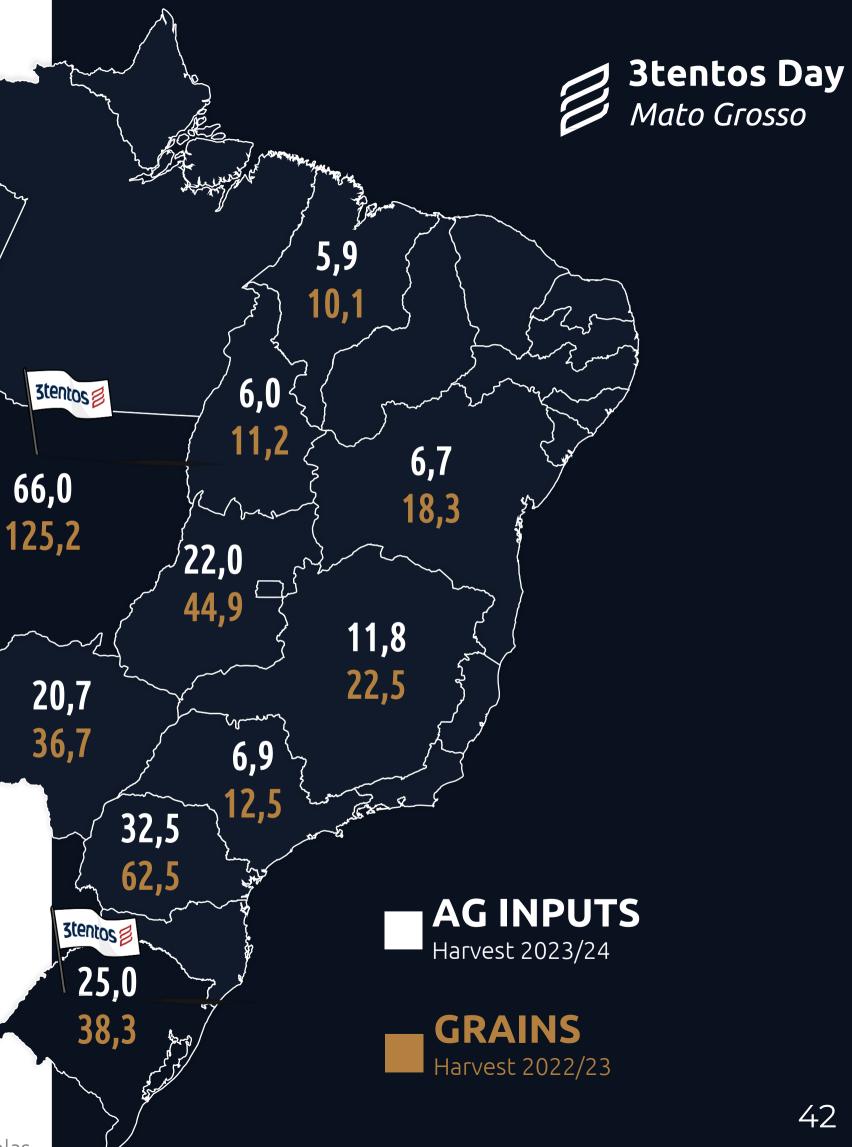
