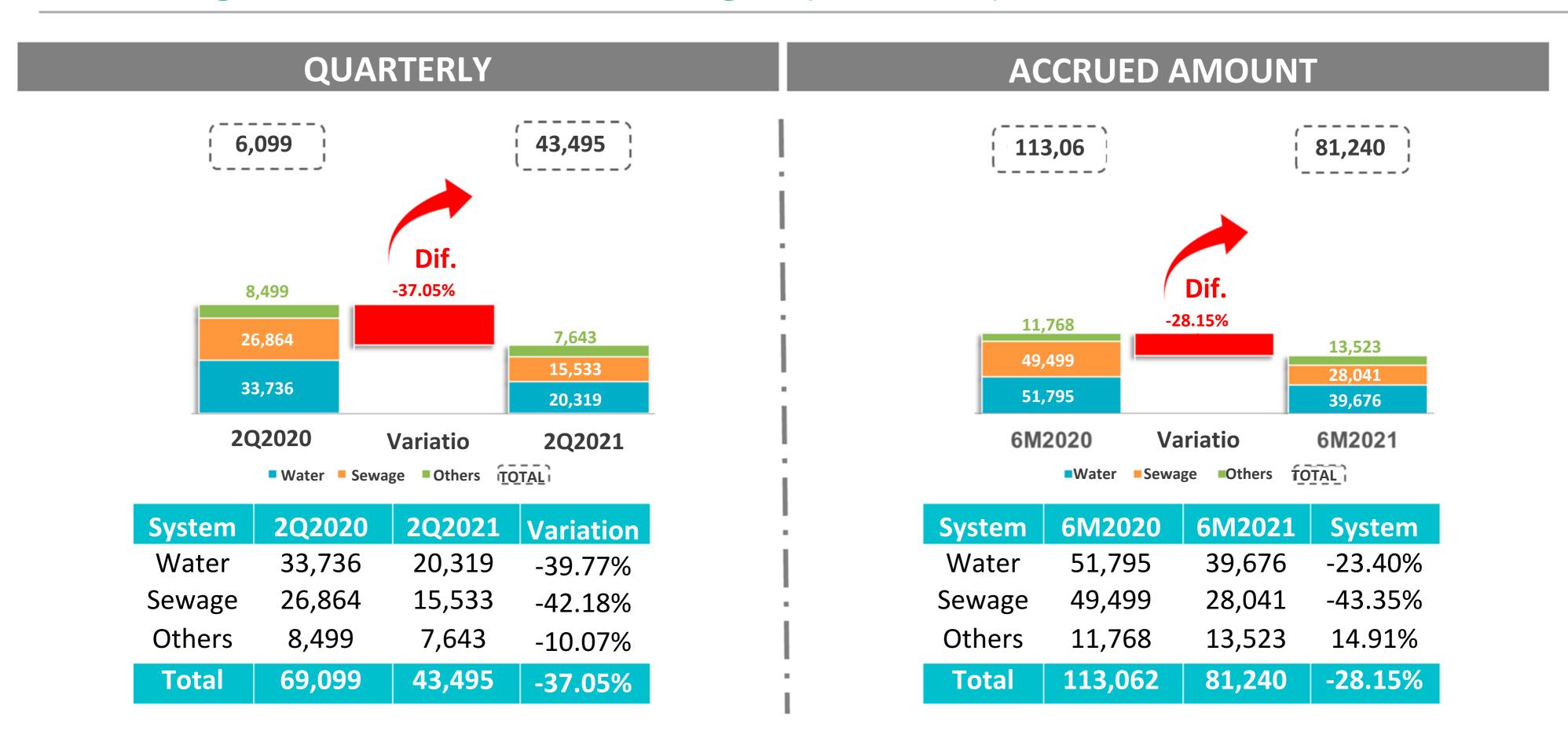

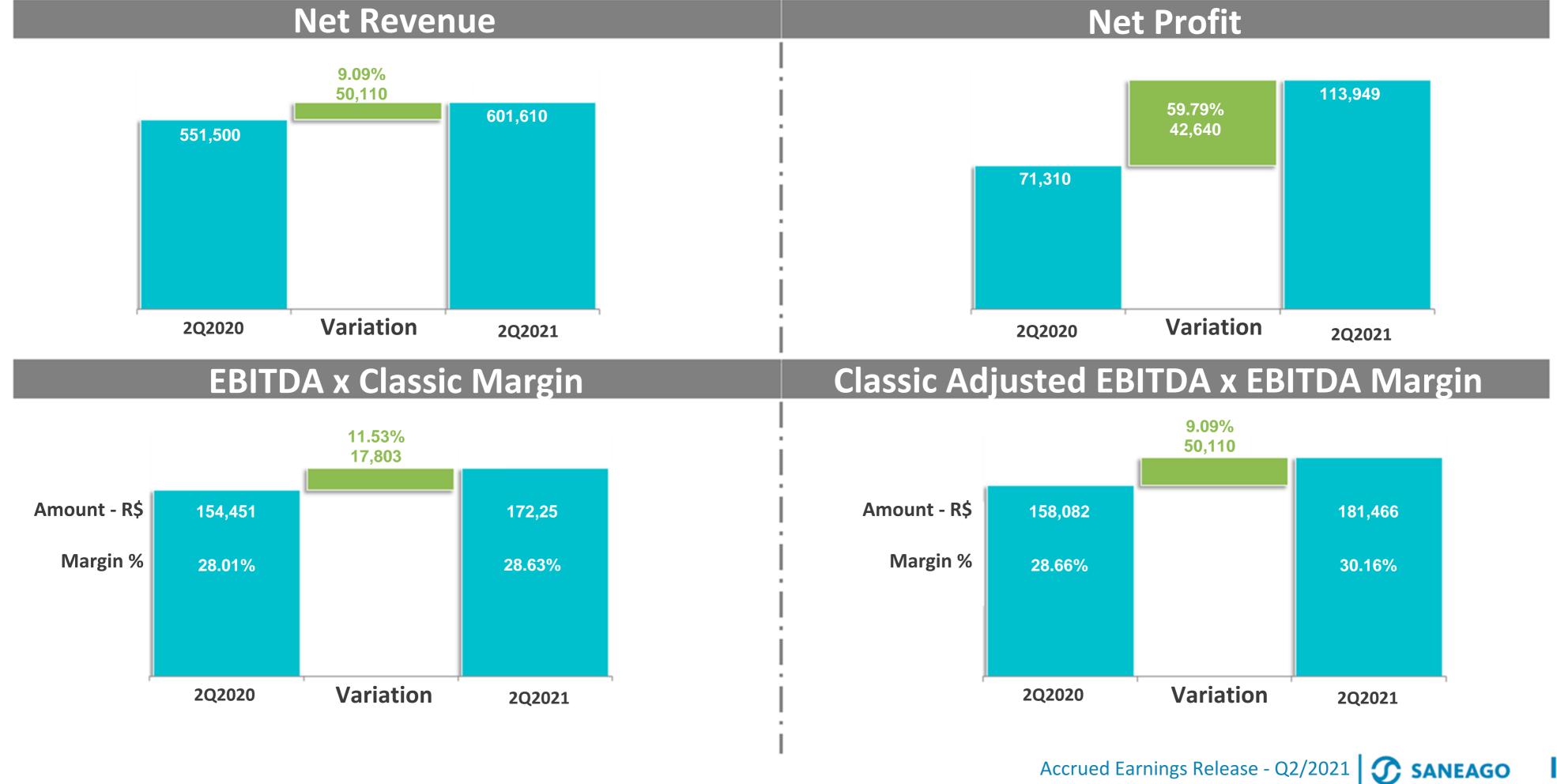

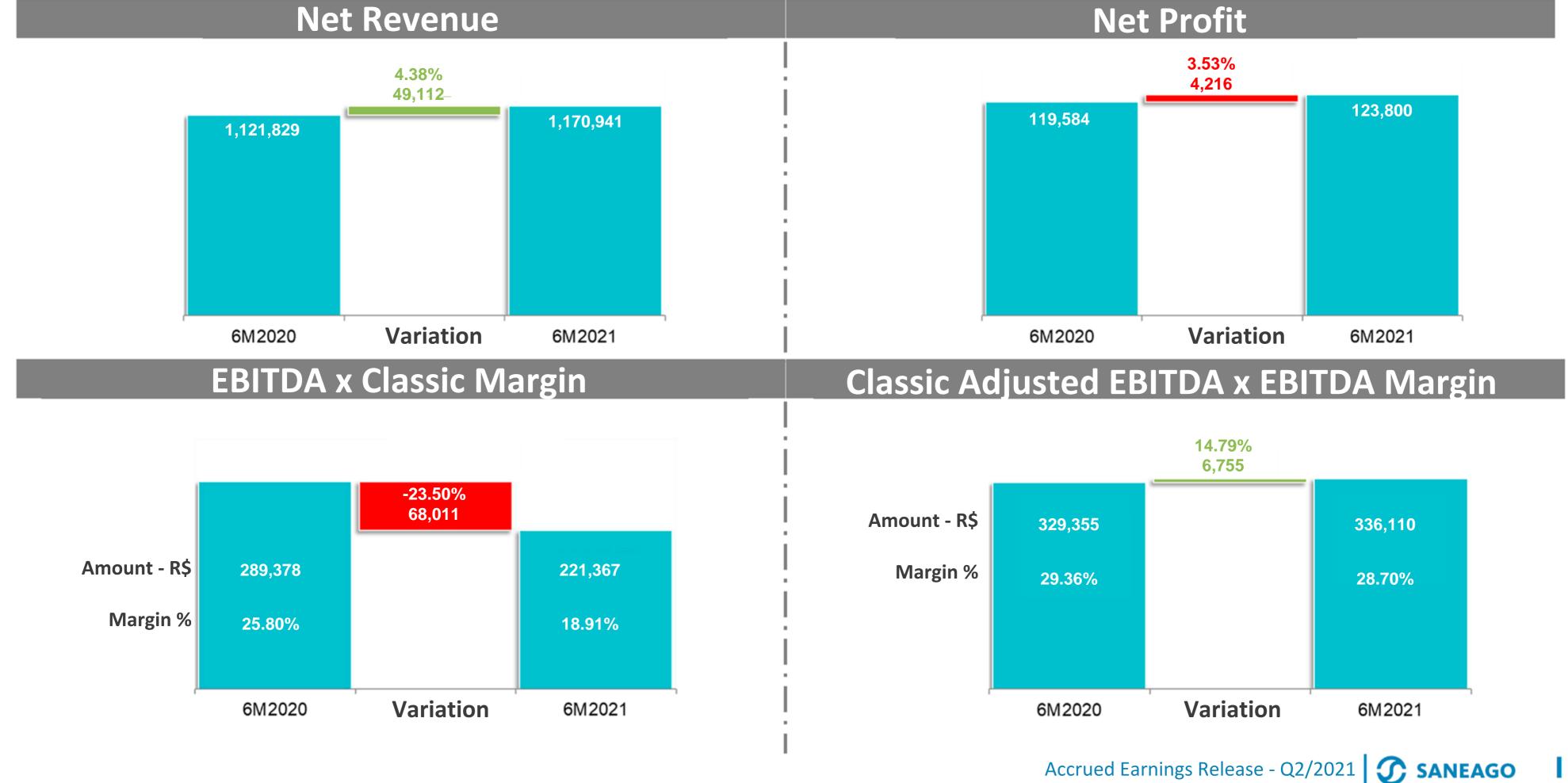

Financial Result Performance - 6M2021 (R\$ millions)

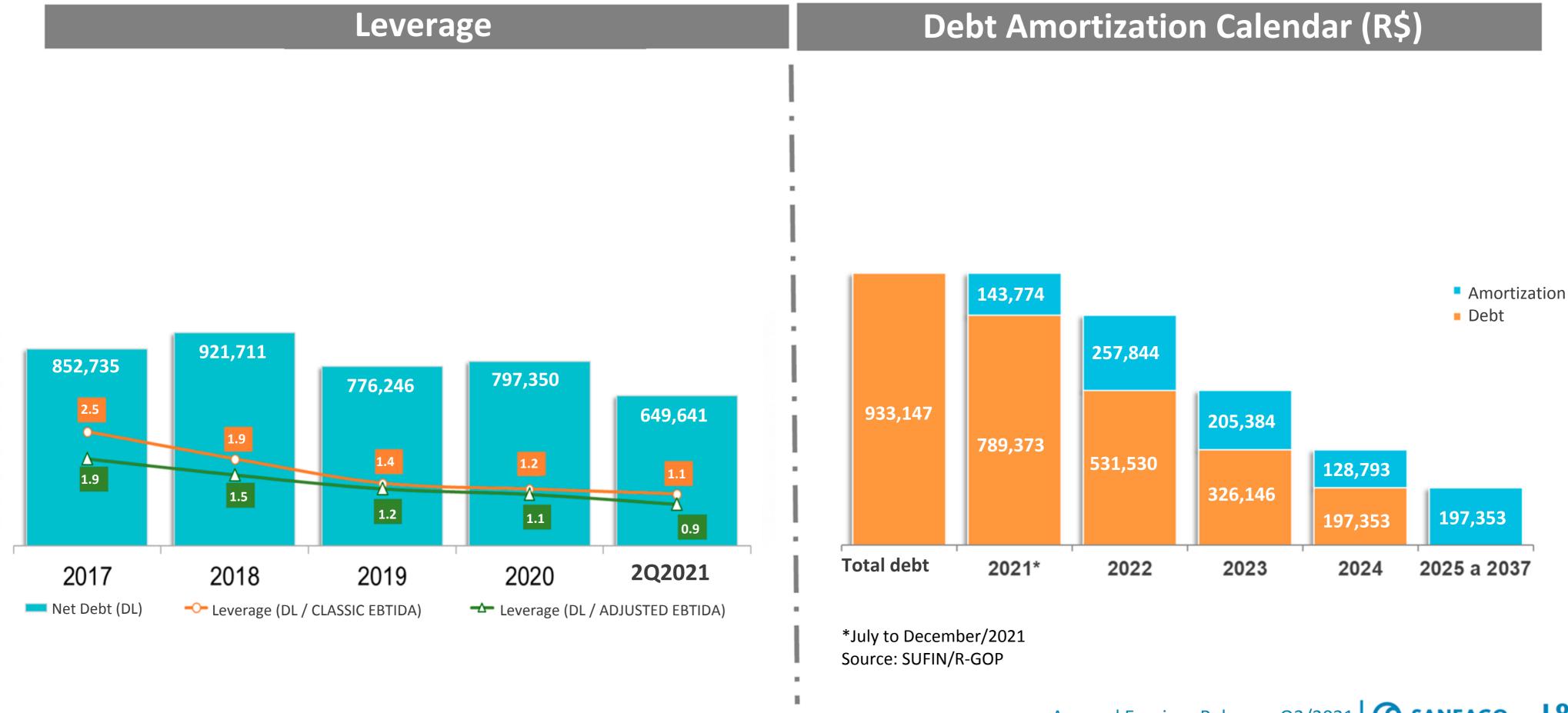
