He has more than 30 years of experience in the Brazilian stock market, having worked 10 years at UBS Pactual (1998-2008) and 7 years at Banco Garantia (1991-1998). At UBS Pactual, he acted as: co-head of Capital Markets (2007-2008), co-head of Equities (2005-2007) and head of Business Analysis and Strategist (1998- 2006). At Banco Garantia, he was a Commodities company analyst (1991-1997) and Investment Banker (1997-1998). He worked on more than 50 transactions in the Brazilian stock market (IPOs), both at Banco Garantia and at UBS Pactual. Since 1995, he is considered by investors as one of the top analysts in Brazil according to several surveys conducted by Institutional Investor magazine. He was ranked "1 Brazil Analyst" from 2003 to 2006 (#3 in 2002, #2 in 2001 and #3 in 2000). He was also ranked as "1 Equity Strategist in Brazil" from 2003 to 2005.
