

Márcio Andrade Weber

- Civil Engineer graduated from UFRGS, with specialization in petroleum engineering by Petrobras.
- Joined **PETROBRAS in 1976**, having worked 16 years in the company. Initially based in Macaé, was one of the pioneers in the development of **Campos Basin**, the most important area of the company and with the greatest technological and operational challenges.
- **He then held several managerial and directive positions** among which stand out activities abroad, in the **international area of Petrobras, in Trinidad, Libya, and Norway.**
- In **Trinidad** (1980 to 81) worked on offshore well drilling acting on behalf of TRINTOC, under a technical assistance contract signed by Petrobras International and that local company.
- **In Libya** (1984 to 86), he served as **General Manager of Brasoil** (services subsidiary of Petrobras International), and was responsible for operating land rigs that drilled for oil companies, including the Italian AGIP, now ENI, in the Sirte and Murzuk basins.
- **In Norway** (1987 to 90), he served as **Operations Manager**, coordinating the exploration of blocks granted by the Norwegian government to the then **Petrobras Norge** in the North Sea offshore.
- Back in Brazil (1990), he took on the position of **Drilling Superintendent for Petrobras** at the company's headquarters in Rio de Janeiro, initiating the plan for adapting and contracting the units for deeper waters in the Campo Basin.
- He was then appointed to the **Service Board of Petrobras International (Braspetro)** where he remained until 92 offering the offshore technology then developed by Petrobras for the Field Basin.
- In 1992 joins the Brazilian group **Petroserv S.A.**, holding the position of **Director**, developing the company's participation in E&P activities, navigation of support and deepwater drilling rigs".
From 08/2007 to 09/2020

In the Exploration and Production (E&P) area of this company, he led it in participation with other oil companies, such as Petrobras, YPF, Repsol, for exploration of areas in the Brazilian offshore. In one of these areas was discovered the Manati gas field, in Bahia.

- As **CEO of BOS Navegação** (a JV between Petroserv and two foreign companies) he was responsible for the construction in national shipyards of 4 support tugboats.

At the same time, as a director of Petroserv, he participated in the construction and operation of 4 deepwater drilling rigs, units that include clients such as Shell and ENI (Indonesia).

- Currently advises the PMI group which operates the said units 09/2020 to date.
