**NOTICE TO THE MARKET**

**ATACADÃO S.A.** (B3: CRFB3) ("Grupo Carrefour Brasil" or "Group"), informs its shareholders and the market in general the composition of its new Executive Committee ("COMEX"), subject to the closing of the transaction contemplated in the Share Purchase, Merger Agreement and Other Covenants, entered into on March 23, 2021 between, on the one hand, the Company, as purchaser, and, on the other, the shareholders of the Grupo Big Brasil S.A. ("Grupo BIG"), as sellers ("Transaction").

Upon completion of the Transaction, COMEX will be expanded to 12 executives, who will report directly to the CEO, reflecting the company's strategic pillars. The future composition of the new leadership will present a balance between professionals who are part of Grupo Carrefour Brasil, employees who come from Grupo BIG and executives from the market.

The participation of women at the company's top management will also be expanded, representing 33% of the total number of executives, covering corporate and business areas.

The new structure will also have two transversal positions to the entire company: Digital and Transformation. The new Transformation area will bring more agility and simplicity to internal processes, being responsible for monitoring the company's strategic transformation projects.

**Stephane Maquaire, CEO of Grupo Carrefour Brasil, declared:** *"We want to build a new company that is based on the strengths of both groups. The new COMEX will materialize our decision to truly integrate and not only acquire. The new structure will also reflect how committed we are to simplification, agility and digitalization of the company, bringing the customer experience even more to the center of our actions."*
