## ANNEX 5.2.1(I) CLIENTCO COLLECTION

The UPI(s) ClientCo will be organized in the form of one or more SPEs and will consist of the assets listed in **Annex 5.2.1(I)** that are part of Oi's operation to provide broadband services via optical fiber to end customers, individuals and legal entities, whose connection is currently provided through Contract No. CT/OI/DA/404-2020 – Contract for Onerous Assignment of FTTH Network Means in an Industrial Exploitation Regime for High-Speed Data Transmission Service and Dedicated Internet Connection entered into between Oi and BRASIL TELECOM COMUNICAÇÃO MULTIMÍDIA S.A. (former denomination of V.tal), dated June 9, 2022 ("V.tal Contract") ("Customers"), as well as the obligations related to such assets expressly provided for in this Annex 5.2.1(i).

The UPI ClientCo will also cover the provision of Value-Added Services and Voice over IP (potentially integrating Oi's service). In general, the assets covered by UPI ClientCo will be those assets that, together with the V.tal Contract or any new contract that may eventually replace it, enable the provision of the aforementioned services described above.

The main assets (not exhaustive) and obligations of UPI ClientCo are:

- 1) Customer base of broadband via optical fiber, from retail and enterprise segments, detailed in **Section A** of this Annex. At the closing date of the sale of UPI ClientCo under the Plan ("<u>UPI ClientCo Closing Date</u>"), such customer base will be updated and will constitute UPI ClientCo for all purposes.
- 2) Terminal equipment of the optical fiber network ONTs (Optical Network Terminal) installed in customers' homes, responsible for transmitting/receiving signals from the FTTH optical fiber network, as well as terminal equipment responsible for customers' Wi-Fi network (Mesh) associated with the service currently named Oi Fibra X, including any inventory of both equipment.
- 3) Systems and platforms used exclusively for the operation of UPI ClientCo, as listed in **Section B** of this Annex, at the discretion of the acquirer of UPI ClientCo, and as defined in the UPI ClientCo Bid, subject to the feasibility of segregation especially in the case of more than one UPI ClientCo. The systems and platforms used by the operation of a UPI ClientCo and also by other businesses of Oi will be segregated or contributed if possible or their use will be carried out through transition service contracts between Oi and UPI ClientCo. In the event that the

systems and platforms are used exclusively for the operation of UPI ClientCo, Oi or its Affiliates will not be entitled to any additional compensation or profit. At the UPI ClientCo Closing Date, **Section B** of this Annex will be updated to reflect all systems and platforms used exclusively for the operation of UPI ClientCo, which will constitute UPI ClientCo for all purposes.

- 4) New contracts equivalent to the V.tal Contract (in substitution for the V.tal Contract), signed between V.tal and the respective SPE of UPI ClientCo or the full or partial assignment, with any amendments if applicable, of Oi's contractual position under the V.tal Contract, including the rights, remedies, and obligations currently held or owed, as applicable, by Oi under such contract (including, but not limited to, rights involving services and assignment of network means in an industrial exploitation regime subject to the V.tal Contract and payment obligations arising from such V.tal Contract, including the debt resulting from the installment of the HC Connection Cost, as updated pursuant to the terms provided in the V.tal Contract).
- 5) Assignment of Oi's contractual position under contracts with suppliers necessary for the operation of UPI ClientCo. The list of key contracts with relevant suppliers for the operation of UPI ClientCo ("Supplier Contracts") is detailed in Section C of this Annex. At the UPI ClientCo Closing Date, this list will be updated to reflect all Supplier Contracts used for the operation of UPI ClientCo as of the UPI ClientCo Closing Date, and which, at the discretion of the acquirer(s) of the respective UPI ClientCo, will be assigned (partially or entirely) to the respective SPE UPI ClientCo and will become part of UPI ClientCo for all purposes.
- 6) Right to use Oi's properties (or other companies within the Oi group) utilized for administrative and operational purposes by UPI ClientCo, which, at the discretion of the acquirer, will be granted through a space rental agreement.
- 7) At the discretion of the acquirer, the employment contracts (existing or new) with employees designated by Oi in the Purchase and Sale Agreement of UPI ClientCo as potentially eligible to be integrated into UPI ClientCo.

"In a consolidated manner, the assets included in UPI ClientCo have the general composition and book value described in **Section D** of this Annex.

Additional shared service contracts with Oi and other companies within the

group may be eventually segregated and included in the list of assets, liabilities, and rights of UPI ClientCo.
