1. INTRODUCTION

JSL, a Brazilian company belonging to the SIMPAR group, aims to provide logistics, road freight and charter services.

In order demonstrate our commitment to treating your personal data securely, transparently and with respect for your privacy at all times, we have drawn up this Privacy Notice, which applies to the website and all the products and services offered by JSL. In this document you will find information on what data we process, for what purposes, what your rights are as a data subject and how to exercise them with us.

We thank you in advance for trusting us when you share your personal data with us and emphasize that we take the security of your information seriously.

If you are an employee, information on how we treat your personal data is available in our Internal Privacy Notice.

2. WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE READING THIS FILE?

If you have any doubts about the terms used in this Notice, we suggest you read the definitions below:

Anonymization: process by which data relating to the Data Subject cannot be identified, taking into account the use of reasonable technical means available at the time of processing.

Employee: all JSL employees, regardless of their position or role.

Controller: the agent responsible for making decisions relating to the Processing of Personal Data, such as the form, duration, means and purpose of the Processing.

Consent: free, informed and unequivocal expression by the Data Subject authorizing the Processing of their Personal Data for a specific Purpose.

Personal Data: any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual. An identifiable individual is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an electronic identifier or to one or more factors specific to physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of such person.

Children's Personal Data: Personal Data relating to the Data Subject up to twelve (12) years of age.

Data Controller: the person appointed by JSL to be responsible for ensuring that your rights are met and for clarifying any doubts about the processing of your Personal Data.

Purpose: the reason why the personal data will be processed, or the objective that the data processing is intended to achieve.

LGPD: General Data Protection Law - Federal Law No. 13709/2018.

Operator: individual or legal entity, whether public or private, in charge of Processing Personal Data on behalf of the Controller.

4.2 Commercial relations - Clients

We process your personal data, as a client, so that we can enable the commercial relationship arising from the contract signed with you, your company, or the company you represent.

To this end, we will process the following data: (i) Registration Data: Full Name, ID, Individual Taxpayers' Register Number (CPF), Driver's License (CNH), Date of Birth, Age, Sex, Physical and Email Address, Telephone Numbers, Profession, Level of Education, Professional Contacts, Affiliation, Spouse's name, Individual Taxpayers' Register Number (CPF) and Date of Birth, as well as Name, Individual Taxpayers' Register Number (CPF) and Date of Birth of Dependents, if applicable; (ii) Bank Details: Bank, Branch and Account Number; (iii) Professional Data: If the services are contracted to companies, the Company Name, National Corporate Taxpayers' Register (CNPJ) Card and Articles of Association; (iv) Contract Data: Existing Contracts, Negotiated Amounts, Amounts connected to the Contracted Services and Legal Representatives; (v) Vehicle Data: Model, Plate and Document; (vi) Official Document Data:

Electronic Transport Document (DT-e) Data, Invoice Data and Electronic Bill of Lading (CT-e) Data; (vii) Insurance Data: Insurance Policy Data and Insurance Waiver Letters; and (viii) Claims Data: Accident Report.

This data is used for the following purposes:

- ❖ To process your requests for quotes, proposals and optimize the process of providing services in general;
- ❖ To create a register in our systems with your information to facilitate and speed up our relationship, including keeping it up to date for future operations and meeting insurance requirements;
- ❖ To carry out credit analysis to guarantee receipt of amounts owed as a result of services rendered;
- ❖ To verify the existence and regularity of the client company, in order to proceed with the provision of services;
- ❖ To keep in contact with you, providing advice and support, with continuous evaluation of quality through surveys;
- ❖ To manage client complaints and problems;
- ❖ To register and grant clients access to JSL's internal platforms;

4.4 Legal or regulatory obligations

In some situations, we are obliged to process some of your personal data to ensure compliance with the law, such as sending invoices and documents to agencies, regulatory bodies and the Public Administration.

To this end, we will process the following data: Full Name, ID, Individual Taxpayers' Register (CPF) Number, Driver's License (CNH), Date of Birth, Age, Gender, Physical and Electronic Address, Telephone Numbers, Profession, Professional Contacts, Contract Data, Insurance Data, Document Data.

4.5 Contacts

JSL has several customer services channels, such as the service form on the website, WhatsApp and telephone. These channels may be used when you wish to receive service or just to send information, whether you are a customer or not. When you enter your data, it is transmitted to us and saved in our database.

In this context, we will send you communications that may be of interest to you, such as information on products, available services and even promotions and offers.

To do this, we will process the following data: Full Name, Individual Taxpayers' Register (CPF), Physical and Email Address, Telephone Contact and, possibly, information about the company that has contracted us.

4.6 Internal Procedures

In order to carry out our regular activities, such as financial and accounting activities, marketing, sales prospecting and the like, we may process some of your Personal Data, such as: Full Name, Signature, ID, Individual Taxpayers' Register Number (CPF), Internal Registration Number, Nationality, Address, E-mail, Telephone Numbers, Date of Birth, Age, Position, Company/Entity/Organization, Professional E-mail, Professional Address, Social Media Profile, Consumer Habits, Purchasing Trends, Browsing Characteristics, Browsing History, Complaint History, Entertainment Preferences, Geolocation, Geolocation History, Credit History, Credit Score, Bank Details (Bank, Branch and Account Number), Credit Card Details and Payment History.

This data is used to:

- ❖ Build and maintain a historical purchasing database;
- ❖ Keep records of commercial transactions and payments;
- ❖ Prepare internal reports and analyses as required;
- ❖ Answer questions and queries from the Board of Directors;
- ❖ Allow third parties and visitors to enter JSL premises;
- ❖ Generate leads and prospect opportunities;

- ❖ Send newsletters, exclusive offers and discounts;
- ❖ File or receive, register and manage legal cases;
- ❖ Answer internal legal queries from JSL and the SIMPAR Group.

4.7 Regular exercise of rights

We may also process some of your personal data when this is necessary to protect our rights. To this end, we will use registration data, as well as other information we have access to, but within the limits imposed by the General Personal Data Protection Act (“LGPD”).

5. WITH WHOM DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

We will share your personal data when necessary to achieve the purpose for which the data was collected or when there is an obligation to do so. Personal data may be shared with:

- ❖ Companies that make up the SIMPAR Business Group to perform the contracted service or offer and supply new products and services;
- ❖ Auditing and compliance companies, to carry out internal audits and analyses;
- ❖ Banking institutions, for payments, reimbursements and granting credit;
- ❖ Insurance brokers, for pricing and taking out insurance, and in the event of a claim involving rented vehicles;
- ❖ Vehicle manufacturers, in the case of vehicle sales;
- ❖ Transportation companies, for delivery of the vehicle or product;
- ❖ Exemption offices, in the case of requests for tax exemption on vehicles for PWDs;
- ❖ Brokers and similar services, for vehicle registration;
- ❖ Government agencies, such as Denatran/Detran and Ciretran for transferring ownership of the vehicle, Finance Departments, the Judiciary and the Federal Revenue Service;
- ❖ Payment and financial institutions, including the Central Bank of Brazil (BACEN);
- ❖ External law firms, to act in extrajudicial, judicial, administrative or arbitration demands or proceedings;
- ❖ Companies that provide services to the SIMPAR Group, such as technology companies and software suppliers like Mobile2You, Dock/Conductor and Mooba; and
- ❖ Companies providing tracking and supply services, in the case of contracting these services.

In order to safeguard your privacy, we use contractual instruments to ensure that the third parties who receive your personal data on our behalf make use the same protection as we do.

Occasionally, your personal data may be transferred outside of Brazil to other companies to help us conduct our business, or to suppliers and business partners located abroad.

6. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS?

As the data subject, you have the following rights:

- ❖ To know whether we are processing your personal data and which data we are processing;
- ❖ Correct or request the correction of incomplete, inaccurate or outdated data;
- ❖ Request the anonymization, blocking or deletion of data that is unnecessary or excessive in relation to the purpose for which it was collected;
- ❖ Request the portability of data to another provider of similar products or services;
- ❖ Obtain information about the public or private entities with which we share your data;
- ❖ When the Processing activity requires your consent, you may refuse to consent. In this case, we will inform you of the consequences of not carrying out this activity;
- ❖ When the Processing activity is based on your consent, you may revoke it at any time.

7. AUTOMATED DECISIONS

8. COOKIES

JSL uses cookies for different purposes, such as to generate access statistics, to enable you to browse without complications and in an agile manner and to remember your language preferences, for example.

A cookie is a small file added to your device or computer to provide you with a personalized access experience, enabling us to analyze internet traffic and know when you have visited a specific website. But rest assured, a cookie does not give access to your computer or reveal information other than that which you choose to share.

Below you will find the categories of cookies we use in our applications and their respective purposes:

Types of cookies	What do they do?
Necessary	These are essential cookies that enable the proper functioning of our website and allow you to make use of all the features available.
Performance	These are cookies that help us understand those interacting with our website, providing information on the areas visited, the time spent on the site and any problems they might have faced.

We will retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose for which it was collected, unless a longer retention period is necessary to comply with legal obligations, safeguard our rights or comply with judicial/extrajudicial settlements.

To determine the retention period of your personal data, we take into account the following criteria:

- ❖ Whether we have a legal, contractual or other obligation to retain personal data, or whether it is necessary for investigation or litigation purposes; and
- ❖ Whether it is necessary to keep accurate business and financial records

10. HOW DO WE KEEP YOUR PERSONAL DATA SAFE?

We have strict policies and procedures in place that determine how personal data should be handled at JSL. These rules seek to ensure that personal data is handled properly and in compliance with applicable laws, avoiding leaks and, consequently, damage to Data Subjects.

We have also technical measures in place to keep your personal data safe and protected from unauthorized access and accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, communication or any other form of inappropriate or unlawful processing, always complying with the applicable data protection and information security rules.

Our security measures are continually monitored and reviewed in line with technological advances and organizational resources.
