



Preliminary Traffic Results

São Paulo, April 22, 2026 – GOL Linhas Aéreas S.A., one of Brazil's leading airlines, announces today preliminary air traffic results for the month of March 2026, compared to the same period in 2025.

Highlights

- GOL's total supply (ASK) increased 10.0%. Total seats increased by 10.8% and the number of departures increased by 11.0%. GOL's total demand (RPK) increased by 8.5% and the load factor was 82.1%.
- GOL's domestic supply (ASK) increased 10.5% and demand (RPK) increased by 9.5%. GOL's domestic load factor was 82.1%. The volume of departures increased by 11.0% and seats increased by 10.8%.
- GOL's international supply (ASK) increased 7.3% and demand (RPK) increased by 3.6%. GOL's domestic load factor was 82.0%. The volume of departures increased by 11.0% and seats increased by 11.0%.
- The average operating passenger fleet was 130 aircraft, while the operating dedicated cargo fleet consisted of 9 aircraft.
