

He raised over \$2.5B in the capital markets and completed over \$1.5B in acquisitions during this time period.

From August 2005 until October 2008, Mr. Smith was the President and CEO of Chevron Mining Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of Chevron Corporation. Prior to August 2005, Mr. Smith was

the Vice President of the Real Estate, Remediation Services, Mining, and Carbon Operations at Unocal Corporation, one of the world's leading independent natural gas and crude oil exploration, production and project development companies.


