

## EXTERNAL PRIVACY NOTICE

**Last updated:** March 27, 2026

We, Cosan S.A. ("Cosan", "we", "us", or "our"), value the protection of Personal Data and the privacy of all our clients, partners, suppliers, service providers, investors, shareholders, visitors to our websites, candidates in recruitment processes, and all individuals who maintain a relationship with us ("you").

Accordingly, we have prepared this Privacy Notice ("Notice") to help you understand which Personal Data we process, for which purposes, and what your rights are as a Personal Data subject. Cosan employees are subject to the Internal Privacy Notice, which may be accessed through Cosan's internal platform.

Please note that the information provided in this Notice refers exclusively to the Personal Data processed by Cosan. For information regarding the data processing activities carried out by other companies within the group, please refer to the relevant website of each company (the "Cosan Group").

### 1. DEFINITIONS

"*ANPD*": means the Brazilian National Data Protection Agency (*Agência Nacional de Proteção de Dados*), the public authority responsible for supervising, implementing, and enforcing the Brazilian General Data Protection Law;

"*Controller*": means the entity that determines the purposes and means of the processing of Personal Data and is generally responsible for matters related thereto;

"*Personal Data*": means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, such as full name, taxpayer registry number (CPF), gender, nationality, marital status, behavior, among others;

*"Sensitive Personal Data"*: means Personal Data relating to racial or ethnic origin, religious beliefs, political opinions, trade union membership, data concerning health or sexual life, and genetic or biometric data when linked to a natural person;

*"DPO" or "Data Protection Officer"*: means the individual designated as the communication channel to address matters related to Personal Data processing;

*"Applicable Legislation"*: means legislation relating to information security, privacy, and data protection, including but not limited to the Brazilian Federal Constitution, Law No. 13,709/2018 (Brazilian General Data Protection Law – "LGPD"), the Consumer Protection Code, the Brazilian Civil Code, Law No. 12,965/2014 ("Brazilian Internet Civil Framework") and its implementing decree, ANPD resolutions, and other sector-specific or general regulations applicable to Cosan;

*"Data Subject"*: means the natural person to whom the Personal Data relates.

*"International Transfer"*: means the transfer of Personal Data or Sensitive Personal Data to another country or international organization of which Brazil is a member;

*"Processing"*: means any operation performed with Personal Data, such as collection, production, receipt, classification, use, access, reproduction, transmission, distribution, processing, archiving, storage, elimination, evaluation or control of information, modification, communication, transfer, dissemination, or extraction.

## **2. WHO WE ARE**

**COSAN S.A.**, headquartered in the city of São Paulo, State of São Paulo, at Avenida Brigadeiro Faria Lima, No. 4,100, 16th floor, room 1, Itaim Bibi, ZIP Code 04538-132, registered with the Brazilian Taxpayer Registry (CNPJ) under No. 50.746.577/0001-15.

Cosan is responsible for the processing of your Personal Data described in this Notice, acting as the data controller.

## **3. HOW DO WE COLLECT YOUR PERSONAL DATA?**

We may collect your Personal Data when it is (i) provided directly by you; (ii) provided by third parties; or (iii) collected automatically.

Personal Data may be provided directly to Cosan when you interact with us, such as when you participate in recruitment processes, contact us through our “Contact Us”, or act as one of our suppliers. We may also receive Personal Data from third parties, including other companies within the Cosan Group, service providers, and credit bureaus. Additionally, we may collect Personal Data automatically when you browse our website or collect information that is publicly available.

#### **4. WHAT PERSONAL DATA DO WE COLLECT?**

We collect only the Personal Data necessary to fulfill specific purposes according to our relationship with you, including primarily:

- **Registration data:** full name, date of birth, identification numbers (RG, CPF, driver’s license, passport number), marital status, nationality, telephone number, email address, and physical address;
- **Financial data:** banking details and credit score;
- **Professional data:** profession, current position, professional and academic background;
- **Corporate data:** politically exposed person (PEP) information and equity interests in companies;
- **Sensitive Personal Data:** health data, data relating to sexual orientation, and racial or ethnic origin;
- **Browsing data:** IP address, operating system, browser type and versions, connection settings, operational preferences, authentication and security information;

- **Images:** video footage captured through closed-circuit television systems, as our headquarters are monitored by cameras for security purposes.

## 5. FOR WHAT PURPOSES DO WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

We use your Personal Data for, among others, the following purposes:

Any additional use of Personal Data will be preceded by an update to this Notice, with prior notice to you whenever feasible.

## 6. HOW DO WE PROCESS PERSONAL DATA OF MINORS?

Our services are not intended for individuals under 18 years of age. We therefore recommend that minors do not browse our website.

Cosan may process Personal Data of minors in connection with apprenticeship and internship programs, strictly as necessary and in the best interests of the minor, pursuant to our Internal Privacy Notice.

## 7. USE OF COOKIES

*Cookies are small files created by websites that are stored in your browser while you browse the internet and help personalize your access. Our cookies are divided into the following categories:*

- **Necessary cookies:** necessary cookies are strictly essential for the proper functioning of the website. Without them, the website would not operate correctly. These cookies enable basic functionalities and security features of the website and app, anonymously. This type of cookie cannot be disabled directly on the website; however, users may configure their browsers to block them. Please note that doing so may affect certain website functionalities.
- **Statistical cookies:** statistical (or analytical) cookies process visitors' interactions anonymously and translate them into detailed behavioral reports. They allow us to count visits and traffic sources in order to measure and improve the performance of our website. All information collected by these cookies is anonymous. Users may disable these cookies; however, this may prevent Cosan from understanding how users interact with the website and/or from identifying issues encountered, such as error messages.
- **Functional cookies:** functional (or preference) cookies remember users' preferences, such as language, location, or customizations made on the website, making navigation more personalized. These cookies generally do not directly identify users; however, if you are logged into your account, some of these cookies may be associated with your profile so that your preferences are applied across different devices. You may disable these cookies through your browser settings, but certain website features may not function properly without them.

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- to facilitate use of the website. We may use cookies that store browsing information and help us better understand user interactions, enabling us to evaluate improvements (for example, layout of content and menus);

- to provide personalized content. We may use cookies that store user preferences (such as language, device and browser information, profile-related information, service usage levels, and pages/sections accessed on the website or app) to personalize content displayed;
- to improve our services. We may use cookies to measure website usage and referral data to help us develop and improve our services. This information allows us to focus on areas of greater user interest and optimize displayed content;
- for security purposes. We may use cookies to verify whether you are connected to a website, application, or system that may compromise the website or any of our systems;
- to obtain metrics. These metrics may vary depending on what our technical team is measuring or analyzing in order to implement improvements to the website;
- social media cookies (such as Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, and Instagram). We use cookies created by social media platforms that allow identification of users and visitors to the website or app. This functionality, which is based on your consent, allows us to use information you have previously provided to those platforms. Information on how social media platforms use such data can be found in their respective Terms of Use and Privacy Policies;
- Google Analytics. Google Analytics features are used to help us better understand how you use the website or app and to improve your experience. These cookies may track browsing behavior, such as time spent on the website or app and the pages or sections visited, allowing us to continue producing effective advertising content. For more information about Google Analytics cookies, please refer to the official Google Analytics website. If you wish to disable Google Analytics cookie collection, you may download the Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on provided by Google or adjust your browser's preference settings.

You may change or disable cookies by adjusting your browser settings.

You may also manage cookies through our Cookies Preference Center, available via the cookie banner displayed in the footer of our website, where you may accept or reject all cookies or select specific categories of cookies.

## **8. FOR WHAT PURPOSES AND WITH WHOM DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?**

In order to properly provide our services, it may be necessary to share your Personal Data with other companies within the Cosan Group and/or with third parties, including our technology providers responsible for operating our website and those required for the provision of our services, as well as our business partners, investors, among others. Such sharing will be limited to the minimum necessary to achieve specific purposes, including, for example:

- processing payments to suppliers;
- sharing information among companies within the Cosan Group;
- maintaining the security of internal systems;
- recruitment and selection processes;
- compliance with our policies and contractual obligations;
- corporate reorganizations, mergers, or sales;
- compliance with legal or regulatory obligations;
- assistance in investigations of suspected or illegal activities; and
- provision of external consulting and legal advisory services.

In addition, while using the website, you may be redirected to third-party websites or platforms. After such redirection, Cosan will no longer be able to apply the rules of this Notice and will not control or be responsible for the privacy and information security practices adopted by such third parties. Cosan has no control over such terms and policies. If you choose to use third-party services or applications, you do so at your own risk.

## **9. DO WE CARRY OUT INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS?**

We may store your Personal Data on servers located outside the national territory, including, but not limited to, cloud computing servers that comply with internationally accepted standards for Personal Data security.

In addition, we may share your Personal Data with third parties located outside the national territory, as described in Section 8 above, when necessary to enable the provision of our services.

In the situations described above, Cosan undertakes to comply with Applicable Legislation in order to ensure the protection of Personal Data, including through the adoption of appropriate contractual safeguards. You may request further information regarding the measures used for such International Transfers through the contact channel provided in this Notice.

#### **10.HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL DATA?**

We adopt appropriate technical and administrative security measures, in compliance with best practices and Applicable Legislation, to protect Personal Data against unauthorized access and against accidental or unlawful situations of destruction, loss, alteration, disclosure, or any form of improper or unlawful Processing.

#### **11.HOW LONG DO WE RETAIN YOUR PERSONAL DATA?**

Personal Data processed by Cosan is retained for determined periods and will be stored for as long as (i) the contractual relationship is maintained, (ii) deletion has not been requested by you, and (iii) such data must not be deleted because it is necessary (a) to comply with a legal and/or regulatory obligation, or (b) for the establishment, exercise, or defense of claims in administrative or judicial proceedings.

Once the retention period has expired or upon your request (where applicable), we will securely delete the Personal Data, unless there is another legal or contractual basis for its retention, such as compliance with a legal obligation, the need to preserve data to protect Cosan's rights or legitimate interests, or pursuant to a court order.

#### **12.WHAT IS THE LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA?**

The legal bases that justify the processing of your Personal Data include the performance of the legal relationship between the parties, compliance with a legal obligation, the

authorizations granted by you pursuant to this Notice, the exercise of rights in judicial, administrative, or arbitration proceedings, and Cosan's legitimate interests.

### **13. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AS A PERSONAL DATA SUBJECT?**

You may exercise the rights provided under Applicable Legislation and this Notice by submitting a request to our Data Protection Officer through the contact channel indicated at the beginning of this Notice. Your rights as a Data Subject include, among others, the right to request:

- (i) confirmation of the existence of Personal Data Processing;
- (ii) access to your Personal Data;
- (iii) correction of incomplete, inaccurate, or outdated Personal Data;
- (iv) anonymization, blocking, or deletion of Personal Data that is unnecessary, excessive, or processed in violation of the LGPD;
- (v) portability of the data, where applicable and in accordance with applicable regulations;
- (vi) deletion of Personal Data processed based on your consent, subject to legal limitations;
- (vii) information regarding public and private entities with which the Controller has shared Personal Data;
- (viii) information about the possibility of denying consent and the consequences thereof;
- (ix) revocation of consent, pursuant to the LGPD;
- (x) objection to Processing carried out based on one of the legal grounds that waive consent, in the event of noncompliance with the LGPD;
- (xi) filing a complaint with the Brazilian National Data Protection Authority (ANPD) regarding your Personal Data; and
- (xii) requesting the review of decisions made solely based on automated Processing of Personal Data that affect your interests.

#### **14.CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY NOTICE**

We may amend this Notice at any time at our sole discretion, and such changes will become valid and binding upon publication on our website or notification to you through another lawful means. By continuing to use Cosan's services and/or by continuing to browse our website, you acknowledge and agree to the updated terms.

If the changes involve modifications to Personal Data Processing practices that require your consent, Cosan will request your express and specific agreement to the updated terms of this Notice.
