



NOTICE TO THE MARKET

At the second cycle of ANP's Open Acreage auction, ENEVA acquires 7 exploratory blocks in Amazonas and Paraná Basins and Juruá Field in the Solimões Basin

Rio de Janeiro, December 4, 2020 – ENEVA S.A. (“ENEVA” or “Company”) (B3: ENEV3), informs that it acquired 7 exploratory blocks in the onshore basins of Amazonas and Paraná, and the Juruá Field in the Solimões Basin, at the second cycle of the Open Acreage Auction (“Open Acreage”), held today by the National Agency of Petroleum, Natural Gas and Biofuels - ANP.

In the Amazonas Basin, in the State of Amazonas, the Company acquired 100% stake in blocks AM-T-62, AM-T-84 and AM-T-85, having offered a Minimum Exploratory Program (“MEP”) total of 11,414 Work Units (“WU”), to be carried out over 8 years, in a total purchased area of 7,224 Km². The signature bonus offered by Eneva for the blocks acquired in the Amazonas Basin was R\$ 16.3 million.

The blocks acquired in the Amazonas Basin are located in the vicinities of the Azulão Field, already operated by Eneva and with the start of natural gas production estimated for the first half of 2021.

In the Solimões Basin, Eneva acquired a 100% stake in the Juruá Field (“Juruá”). Juruá is located in the municipalities of Tefé and Carauari, 725 km southwest of the City of Manaus, State of Amazonas; and 110 km west of the Urucu oil and gas fields. According to the Juruá Development Plan, prepared by Petróleo Brasileiro S.A. - Petrobras and approved by the ANP in 2012, the volume of non-associated gas in place in Juruá is 25.9 billion cubic meters. The signature bonus offered by Eneva for Juruá was R\$ 25.7 million.

In the Paraná Basin, Eneva acquired a 70% stake in blocks PAR-T-196, PAR-T-215, PAR-T-86 and PAR-T-99, in partnership with Enauta Energia S.A., with a 30% stake. The consortium will be operated by Eneva. The total value of the signature bonuses offered for these exploratory blocks was R\$ 2.1 million, being R\$ 1.5 million net for Eneva. The MEP offered for 100% of the blocks in the Paraná Basin was 7,548 WUs, to be carried out over 6 years. The blocks in the Paraná Basin are located in the States of Mato Grosso do Sul and Goiás, with an area of approximately 11,544 km², greater than that of the entire Recôncavo Basin, in the State of Bahia.

According to the ANP's schedule, the signing of the concession contracts of the winning companies of the auction is set to take place until June 30, 2021.

The new assets will complement the Company's portfolio, which already has 45,784 km² under concession in the Parnaíba and Amazonas Basins, in the form of exploratory blocks, areas under development and ten fields declared commercial. The result of the 2nd cycle of the Open Acreage marks Eneva's entry into two new basins with potential for onshore exploration and production of hydrocarbons and strengthens the

Company's presence in the northern region of the country, continuing the development of the Reservoir-to-Wire model (R2W), which integrates onshore gas production with energy generation, and the execution of plans for the commercialization of natural gas.
