

MATERIAL FACT

Ambipar Participações e Empreendimentos S.A. (“Ambipar” or “Company”) (B3: AMBP3), in accordance with Article 157, paragraph 4th of Brazilian Corporation Law (Law No. 6,404/76, dated as of December 15th, 1976), as amended, and with CVM Instruction No. 358, dated as of January 3rd, 2002, as amended, hereby inform to its shareholders and the market in general that, it has **acquired the remaining 50,0% of Suatrans Chile S.A.** (“Suatrans”), through its controlled company Emergência Participações S.A..



Suatrans has been operating for over 20 years in Response segment, focusing on **environmental emergencies in all modes of transport** (sea, road, rail, pipeline and air). It is the **market leader in Chile**, where it also provides complete assistance services on the main highways, such as pre-hospital, tow truck and patrol.



It has **30 bases strategically positioned** in Chile, Peru, Uruguay and Colombia and 3 training camps, two in Chile and one in Peru.



Added to the acquisition of Disal, Ambipar **will capture** the administrative, operational and commercial **synergies** of the Environment and Response segments in Latin America, as it has done in Brazil. Suatrans will use the **Ambipar Response** brand.



For Ambipar, this acquisition: (i) **fully consolidates the income from these operations**; (ii) **generates synergies**; (iii) **allows the start of highway service services**; and (iv) **accelerates organic and inorganic growth** in the region; in line with its strategic growth plan, capturing synergies and potentially maximizing margins and returns.

The Company clarifies that this acquisition will not be submitted to the approval of its shareholders, nor will it be entitled to withdrawal, considering that it was carried out through its subsidiary, a closed corporation.
