NOTICE TO THE MARKET

Ambipar Participações e Empreendimentos SA ("Ambipar" or "Company") (B3: AMBP3), informs its shareholders and the market in general, with great satisfaction, that Biofílica Ambipar Environmental SA, one of the group companies, announces a contract for partnership to develop a carbon project in the Amazon, in the state of Pará using the REDD+ mechanism (Reduction of Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation, in addition to promoting (+) sustainable forest management, conservation and increase in forest carbon stocks) with Agropalma, one of the largest producers of vegetable oil in Latin America.

For Biofílica, this partnership makes the company become a leader in Brazil in terms of conservation and carbon projects with high credibility. Biofílica has in its portfolio of projects a large area certified for forest carbon credits in the Amazon, exceeding 1.7 million hectares under conservation.

Agropalma, located in the municipality of Thailand, Pará, recalls that REDD+ projects combine activities such as sustainable management, promotion of agro-extraction and Biodiversity monitoring, which will be financed through the sale of carbon credits. The company today already conserves more than 64,000 hectares in the Amazon, investing around R\$ 1.5 million per year in its Forest Protection program.

In the sense of preservation, Agropalma works daily to protect biodiversity and, by 2019, more than 1,000 species, including vertebrates and invertebrates, were registered and monitored in forest reserves. The company has a team of 25 forest watchers exclusively dedicated to patrolling, two inspectors, a supervisor and a coordinator, who monitor fire prevention and forest protection.

We are delighted to have Agropalma as a new partner in the Amazon conservation challenge. There is a great alignment between the companies when it comes to the vision of socioeconomic development financed by payment for Environmental Services”, explains Plínio Ribeiro, co-founder and CEO of Biofíllica.

For Ambipar, this partnership: (i) represents the importance of conserving the Amazon Forest (ii) allows access to strategic information for the conservation of more than 64 thousand hectares, (iii) puts into practice the REDD+ mechanism in Agropalma's Forest Reserves further expanding its portfolio of Carbon and Nature Based Solutions projects.

Furthermore, the Company reiterates that it will keep the market informed, we are at your disposal for any additional clarifications that may be necessary.
