### **MATERIAL FACT**

#### Agreement for Acquisition of Authorization for Use of Radio Frequency in the 3.5 GHz Band in the State of Paraná

**Unifique Telecomunicações S.A. (“Company”)**, in compliance with the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 157 of Law No. 6,404, of December 15, 1976 (“Corporation Law”), and pursuant to CVM Resolution No. 44, dated August 23, 2021, hereby informs its shareholders and the market in general that, on January 27, 2026, it entered into an agreement for the acquisition of the Radio Frequency Use Authorization, on a primary basis, for the 80 MHz block in the 3.5 GHz band, in the state of Paraná.

The radio frequency is owned by LIGGA Telecomunicações S.A., winner, through the 5G Sul Consortium, of Lot C6, corresponding to the 3,620 MHz to 3,700 MHz band, in the 5G auction promoted by the National Telecommunications Agency – ANATEL.

The Authorization for Use of Radio Frequency Blocks was issued for a period of 20 (twenty) years, extendable, for a fee, in accordance with the regulations in force at the time of its expiration.

According to the agreement, Unifique will undertake the investments in telecommunications infrastructure necessary to fulfill the coverage commitments assumed by LIGGA in municipalities in the state of Paraná, using a technological standard equal to or superior to 5G NR, between 2026 and 2030.

The investment commitments include serving 336 (three hundred and thirty-six) municipalities in the state of Paraná, all with a population of less than 30,000 (thirty thousand) inhabitants, through the installation of 745 (seven hundred and forty-five) Radio Base Stations. The municipalities covered by these commitments are detailed in the annexes to the public auction notice issued by ANATEL.

The purchase price for the right to use the radio frequency is BRL 20,000,000.00 (twenty million reais), to be paid as follows: (i) BRL 10,000,000.00 (ten million reais) on the date the contract is signed; (ii) BRL 5,000,000.00 (five million reais), within thirty (30) days after payment of the first installment; and (iii) BRL 5,000,000.00 (five million reais), within ten (10) days after approval of the transaction by ANATEL and other conditions precedent.

Additionally, the Company will be responsible for paying the remaining amount of the concession, which, in 2021, corresponded to BRL 1,762,425.51 (one million, seven hundred and sixty-two thousand, four hundred and twenty-five reais and fifty-one centavos), to be paid in 20 (twenty) annual installments, in accordance with applicable regulations.

The acquisition of radio frequency allows the Company to expand its geographical area of operation by approximately 60% (sixty percent) in mobile telephony with its own infrastructure, now covering the

entire southern region of Brazil. With the inclusion of Paraná, Unifique's potential market reaches all 1,191 (one thousand one hundred and ninety-one) municipalities in the southern region, with 497 (four hundred and ninety-seven) in Rio Grande do Sul, 295 (two hundred and ninety-five) in Santa Catarina, and 399 (three hundred and ninety-nine) municipalities in Paraná. This expansion increases the population covered from approximately 18.6 million inhabitants to more than 30 million people, with the integration of 11.4 million residents of Paraná, consolidating the Company's presence in strategic areas with high growth potential.
