<sup>4 -</sup> From the second quarter of 2023 onwards, an important improvement in performance was observed, positively driven by the start of charging for suspended axles on heavy vehicles through the Manifesto Eletrônico de Documentos Fiscais (MDF-e). The implementation of this practice began in May 2023 by ViaSul and ViaCosteira, in August by RioSP, in October by AutoBAn, ViaOeste, SPVias, RodoAnel and MSVia, and finally, Renovias, ViaLagos and ViaRio in January 2024.
