NOTICE TO THE MARKET

Companhia de Saneamento de Minas Gerais - COPASA MG hereby announces to its shareholders and the public in general that measures have been taken to help victims affected by the storms in the state of Minas Gerais. These measures, which have the agreement of the Regulatory Agency for Water Supply and Sanitary Sewage Services (ARSAE-MG), are based on Article 94 of Resolution ARSAE-MG No. 40/2013, and subsequently the appropriate tariff compensations will be carried out.

Conditions vary according to the situation of each property and are summarized below:

- **Properties that collapsed and / or were condemned:** exemption from bill with reference February/2020 (with maturity from 11 February 2020). In such cases, COPASA MG will cut the supply, and the customer will not receive new bills.
- **Properties temporarily banned, belonging to the Social Tariff category:** exemption from bill with reference February/2020. In addition, there will be an exemption of 3 (three) bills after reconnection, provided that reconnection takes place within 180 days after the supply is cut.
- **Properties temporarily banned, not belonging to the Social Tariff category:** exemption from bill with reference February/2020. In addition, there will be an exemption of the 1st (first) bill after the water reconnection, as long as the reconnection occurs within 90 days after the supply is cut.
- **Properties that are still in use / housing conditions, but have been flooded, with damage or loss of movable property, belonging to the Social Tariff category:** exemption from bills with reference February/2020, March/2020, April/2020 and May/2020.
- **Properties that are still in use / housing conditions, but have been flooded, with damage or loss of movable property, not belonging to the Social Tariff category:** exemption from the bills for February/2020 and March/2020.

The Company also informs that (i) only properties belonging to the Social, Residential and Commercial categories will be benefited, except for large users; (ii) the costs of buffering (cut off supply) and reconnecting the properties that were condemned will not be paid by the customer; (iii) suspension of overdue debts for (2) two months, except for the Social category, which will be suspended for (4) four months; and (iv) clients will not need to travel to the branch in the municipality, since it will be up to the Company to evaluate and list the affected properties.
