### **ARSESP RESOLUTION 1,395 of April 06, 2023**

*Provides for the approval of the new tariffs of water supply and sewage services provided by Companhia de Saneamento Básico do Estado de São Paulo – SABESP and revokes ARSESP Resolution 1,278, of March 16, 2022.*

The Executive Board of the São Paulo State Utility Service Regulatory Agency - ARSESP, according to State Supplementary Law 1,025, of December 7, 2007, and State Decree 52,455, of December 7, 2007:

*Considering that ARSESP has authority to regulate and oversight the provision of basic sanitation services in the municipalities, including regarding tariffs, according to Law 11,445, of January 5, 2007, and Supplementary Law 1,025/07, of December 07, 2007;*

*Considering the terms of the Cooperation Agreements entered into between the municipalities and the São Paulo State, which granted ARSESP the regulation, including tariff regulation, of said provision of services;*

*Considering the Program Contracts and the Service Agreements to operate basic sanitation services executed by Companhia de Saneamento Básico do Estado de São Paulo – Sabesp and the respective holders of the service;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 870, of May 13, 2019, which established*

*criteria and conditions for tariff recognition regarding the transfer of part of direct revenue from providers regulated by ARSESP to municipal basic sanitation funds;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolutions that qualified the municipal basic sanitation funds based on ARSESP Resolution 870, of May 13, 2019;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 920, of November 22, 2019, which created the Four-Year Technological Research and Development Program for Innovation in Basic Sanitation Services;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 1,107, of December 29, 2020, which established the classification and criteria for approval of Sabesp's alternative revenue-generating activities;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 106, of November 13, 2009, which established the general conditions for the provision and use of water supply and sewage services;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 818, of November 1, 2018, which provided for the criteria for executing and overseeing water supply and sewage contracts for large users in the non-residential categories;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 1,290, of May 06, 2022, which changes ARSESP Resolution 818, of November 01, 2018;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 1,150, of April 8, 2021, which provides for the results of the 3rd Ordinary Tariff Revision and the Tariff Structure Revision of Companhia de Saneamento Básico do Estado de São Paulo – Sabesp;*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 1,278, of March 16, 2022, which provides for the tariffs currently practiced by the company;*

*Considering technical report PARECER.TEC-0006-2023, referring to the results of the General Quality Index (GQI), corresponding to 2022;*

*Considering Technical Note TN.F-0013-2023, which presented the calculation of the tariffs to be applied as of May 10, 2023,*

*Considering ARSESP Resolution 1,394, of April 06, 2023, which provides for the result of Sabesp's Extraordinary Tariff Review and compensatory adjustments;*

## **RESOLVES TO:**

Article 1 Approve the total adjustment of 9.5609% (nine point five six zero nine percent) on the tariffs currently practiced by Sabesp, according to the exhibits to this resolution, which consist of:

I - Inflation from February/2022 to February/2023, as measured by the IPCA, of 5.5964%;

II - Efficiency factor (X Factor) to be discounted, of 0.2142%;

III – 2023 General Quality Index (GQI) 2023 to be discounted, of 0.1280%, according to the calculation provided in TN.F-0013-2023.

IV – Result of the Extraordinary Tariff Review, of 5.5532%, according to TN.F-0012-2023;

V – Compensatory adjustment referring to 2021, of 1.4040%, according to the calculation provided in TN.F-0010-2022, to be discounted.

Paragraph 1. The amounts in the exhibits consist of ceiling tariffs, and any discounts may preserve the economic-financial balance of the contracts and equality among users, including all those who are part of the same category, except in the event of this paragraph 2.

Paragraph 2. The maximum limit of water supply and sewage service tariffs for users with monthly consumption higher than 100 m<sup>3</sup>/month, from the non-residential categories, are those included in the tables for non-residential consumption higher than 50 m<sup>3</sup>/month, whereby Sabesp has the option to charge lower prices, according to ARSESP Resolution 818/2018 and 1.290/2022.

Paragraph 3. Tariffs lower than the fixed ceiling tariffs are deemed as goodwill and cannot be a burden to other users nor generate future compensations in favor of Sabesp.

Paragraph 4. Tariffs lower than the fixed ceiling tariffs are subject to analysis by ARSESP, which may request spreadsheets to evaluate the cost of services.

Article 2. The adjusted tariffs will become effective as of May 10, 2023.

Article 3. Those users who meet at least one of the criteria below will be eligible for the Social Residential tariff:

I - be registered in CadÚnico with a monthly per capita income between the second registration range registry and ½ minimum wage;

II - be unemployed, having been paid up to 3 minimum wages in his/her last job, with maximum consumption of 15 m<sup>3</sup>/month; be the person responsible for the bill for more than 90 days; have not been dismissed for cause and have no debts with Sabesp;

III - live in social collective housings (slums and vertical housing), such as the Vertical Social Unit resulting from the urbanization of slums.

Paragraph 1. For the purposes of item I of this article, Sabesp shall record the units that meet such a condition in the Social Residential category, immediately and automatically, as of May 10, 2023, as established in paragraph 2 of article 6 of ARSESP Resolution 1,150, of April 08, 2021.

Paragraph 2. If the immediate and automatic registration is not possible, as provided for in the previous paragraph, Arsesp may, provided that the reason for the impediment is duly proven and justified by Sabesp, authorize the extension of the term for up to 180 days, for it to become effective.

Paragraph 3. In case of extension, according to paragraph 2 of this article, Sabesp shall apply, for the term extended, upon evaluation of the company's commercial areas, the tariff of the Social Residential category to users with a family income of up to 3 (three) minimum wages, who live in single-family subnormal housing, with usable floor area of up to 60m<sup>2</sup>, and energy consumption of up to 170 kWh/months, who are not eligible for the hypothesis provided for in items I, II, and III of article 3 of this Resolution.

Paragraph 4. The maximum term for the granting of the benefit, in the case addressed by item II of this article, will be 12 months.

Article 4. Users registered in CadÚnico, with a monthly per capita income eligible in the first registration range will be entitled to the Vulnerable Residential tariff.

Article 5. Users who provide the following services and activities will be entitled to the "Commercial /Social Welfare Entity" tariff:

I - children and adolescent care;

II - shelter for children and adolescents;

III - assistance to people with disabilities;

IV - elderly care;

V - assistance to sick people in general: Santas Casas de Misericórdia, health care centers, outpatient clinics, and social assistance hospitals;

VI - shelters;

VII - therapeutic communities - care for drug addicts;

VIII - support groups and/or shelters that offer continued treatment to all sick patients; and

IX - food programs registered with the federal, state, or municipal governments.

Paragraph 1. The classification of the user unit as a social welfare entity will be made after evaluation by Sabesp's commercial areas, according to the Company's

normative rulings.

Paragraph 2. Users are required to present the certifications and other documents in accordance with SABESP's regulatory procedures.

Paragraph 3. Users must honor their obligations with Sabesp.

Article 6. Direct Federal Public Government Entities, State Secretariats, and Municipal Governments that execute agreements with Sabesp will be entitled to the tariff of the "Public with Contract" category.

Sole paragraph. The entities referred to in the main section of this article must not be in default when executing the contract, and honor their obligations with Sabesp.

Article 7. Sabesp's current tariff structure remains unchanged.

Article 8. This Resolution shall come into effect on the date of its publication, and revokes the provisions to the contrary, especially ARSESP Resolution 1,278, of March 16, 2022.
