MATERIAL FACT

BRK AMBIENTAL PARTICIPAÇÕES S.A. ("**BRK**" or "**Company**"), for the purposes of the Resolution No. 44, dated August 23rd, 2021 of the Brazilian Securities and Exchange Commission (*Comissão de Valores Mobiliários* – "CVM"), hereby announces that, on this date, a consortium maintained between the Company and Acciona Agua S.A. ("Acciona"), a Spanish company with a global presence and a long history of operating in Brazil in the infrastructure sector, was declared the winner in the bidding process conducted by the Government of the State of Pernambuco, in the international competitive bidding modality, after presenting a fixed grant value of R\$ 3.5 billion, with a 5% tariff discount, referring to the concession for the regionalized provision of public services for the distribution of treated water and wastewater treatment, as well as complementary services, related to the RMR Pajeú (Block 2), in the State of Pernambuco, under the terms of the International Public Bidding Notice No. 0021.2025.0021.SHRS, dated September 15, 2025 ("Tender" and "Bid Notice", respectively).

The bidding process, which will be operated through a special purpose entity to be formed in partnership between the Company and Acciona, with a joint control structure in the proportion of 50%/50% between the shareholders, covers 151 municipalities in the State of Pernambuco, with an estimated population of 7 million inhabitants, including the Metropolitan Region of Recife, for a term of 35 years.

The conclusion of the bidding process and the signing of the Concession Contract are subject to the fulfillment of certain conditions and obligations stipulated in the Bid Notice, among which the main ones are: (i) the analysis of the qualification documentation of the highest-ranked bidder; (ii) the observance of any administrative appeal deadlines; (iii) the awarding of the contract and the approval of the result by the competent authority; and, subsequently, (iv) the signing of the Interdependence Agreement.

In the state of Pernambuco, BRK already has a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) that has been providing sanitation services to 15 municipalities in the Recife Metropolitan Region since 2013, and which remains in operation with the same commitments.

The result of the bidding process represents a significant milestone in the Company's strategic planning, oriented towards sustainable growth based on efficiency combined with assertive capital allocation. Furthermore, it captures synergies with the current operation, allowing for resource optimization and economies of scale, as well as regulatory, operational, and administrative integration in the State of Pernambuco.

The Company will keep the market duly informed about any relevant information regarding the Tender, in accordance with applicable regulations and best market disclosure practices, through its usual communication channels: the CVM website (www.gov.br/cvm) and the Company's website (<https://www.ri.brkambiental.com.br/>).
