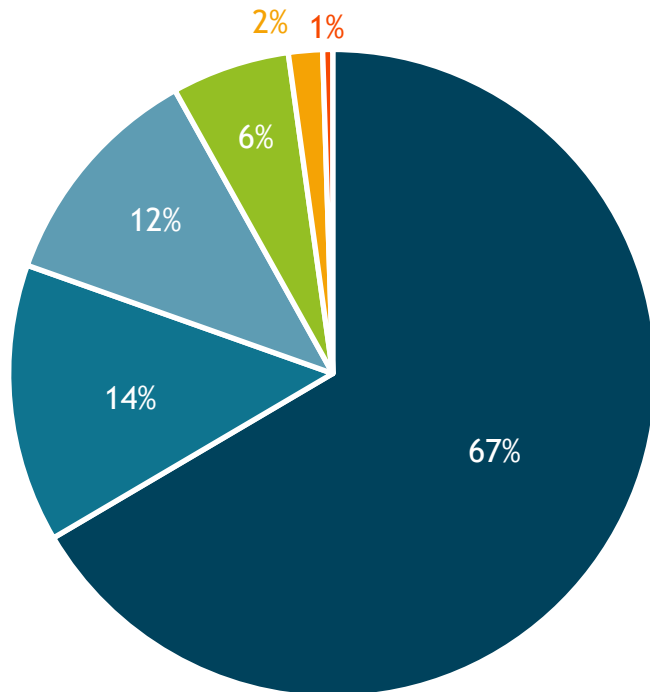

GROSS REVENUE BY SECTOR, 2022



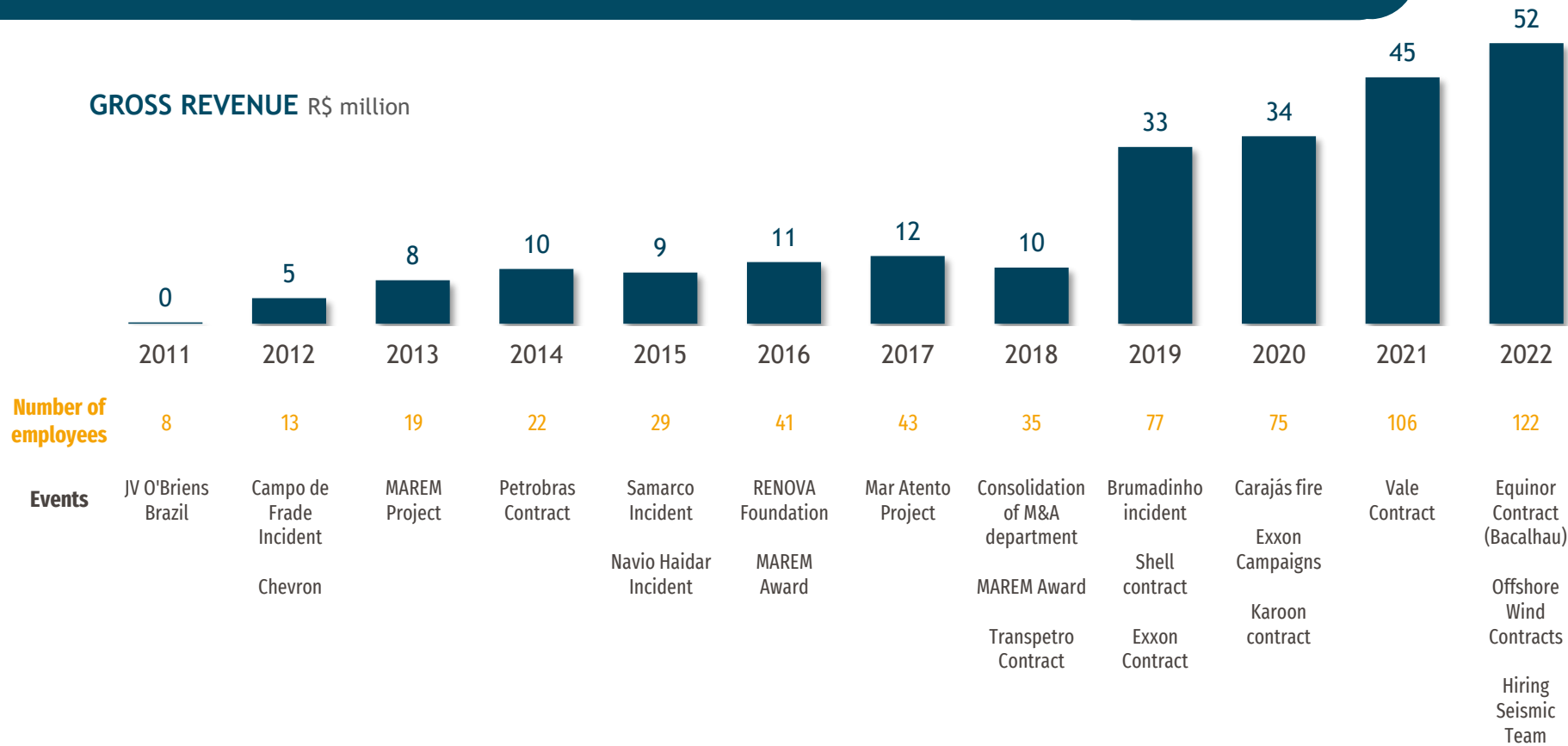

Strong Growth In Recent Years

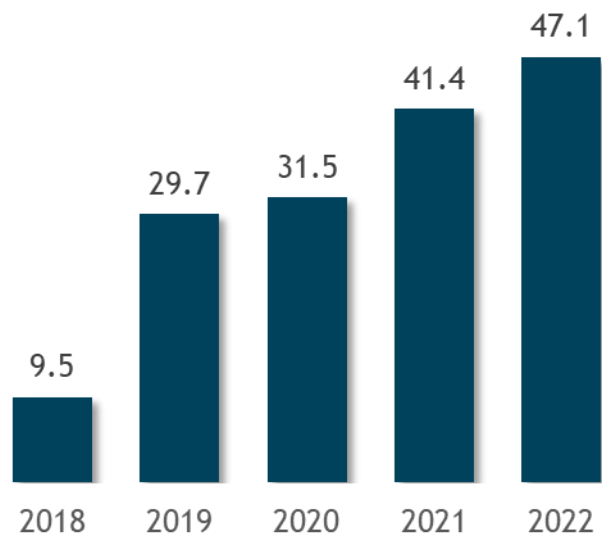
GROSS REVENUE R\$ million



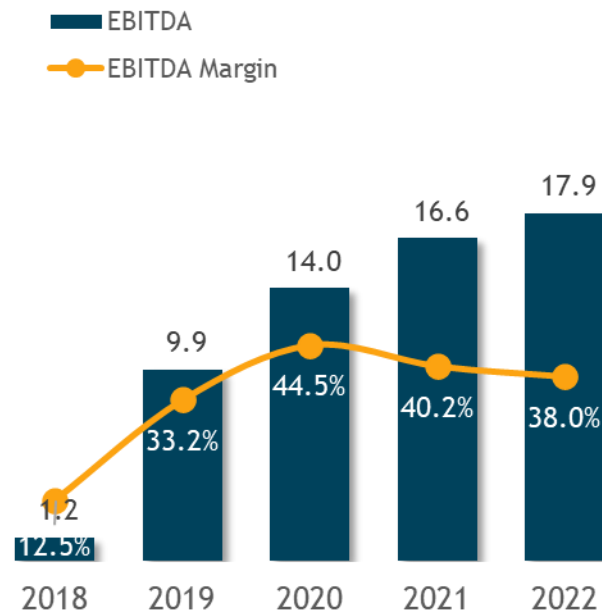
