

Azul's first Airbus A350 aircraft arrives in Brazil

With capacity for up to 334 customers and about 20% less fuel consumption per seat, the aircraft is part of Azul's fleet modernization plan

São Paulo, September 16, 2022 – Azul S.A., "Azul", (B3: AZUL4, NYSE: AZUL), the largest airline in Brazil in terms of number of flights and cities served, announces that the first Azul Airbus A350 aircraft is already on Brazilian ground, under the name "50 também é Azul". The aircraft departed from Tarbes, France, where it completed the last maintenance checks before being delivered to Azul and landing at Confins airport in Minas Gerais.

With capacity for 334 customers, A350's structure has more than 70% of its composition of state-of-the-art items such as composites, titanium, and modern aluminum alloys to create a lighter and more economical aircraft, which increases its technical-operational efficiency.

According to Azul's CEO, John Rodgerson, A350 is part of the company's fleet renewal plan and will replace the A330CEO aircraft. "We are very happy to present this news to our Customers, Crew and partners. The Airbus A350 is one of the most modern aircraft in existence, which will bring much more comfort to our customers and more efficiency in terms of fuel consumption and CO_2 emission, bringing a reduction in the cost per seat when compared to the A330CEO aircraft, which currently fly Azul's long-haul flights", highlighted the CEO.

One of the key differentiators of A350 is its comfort. Customers on board will appreciate a more silent, wider cabin, as well as larger panoramic windows and more space in the baggage compartments. The aircraft is equipped with two Trent XWB turbofan engines, which guarantee 20% less fuel consumption per seat, resulting in much lower CO_2 emissions per seat compared to the A330CEO, reinforcing Azul's commitment to sustainability and to achieving carbon neutrality by 2045.

In the coming weeks, the aircraft should also complete the certification process with the Brazilian regulatory agencies. By the end of the year, two new generation Airbus A350 aircraft will be flying on Azul's network, replacing two older generation A330CEO aircraft.
