NOTICE TO THE MARKET

CORSAN FILES REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF ECONOMIC-FINANCIAL CAPACITY

Companhia Riograndense de Saneamento – Corsan (“Company”) hereby informs that, on this date, it has filed the Requirements for the Certification of Economic-Financial Capacity (“Requirements”) to the Agencies that regulate its 307 valid contracts, namely the Public Services Regulatory Agency of the State of Rio Grande do Sul (AGERGS - Agência Estadual de Regulação dos Serviços Públicos Delegados do Rio Grande do Sul), the Sanitation Intermunicipal Regulatory Agency of the State of Rio Grande do Sul (AGESAN - Agência Reguladora Intermunicipal de Saneamento do Rio Grande do Sul), the Delegated Public Services Regulatory Agency of Santa Cruz (AGERST - Agência Reguladora de Serviços Públicos Delegados de Santa Cruz), and the Delegated Services Municipal Regulatory Agency of São Borja (AGESB - Agência Municipal de Regulação dos Serviços Delegados de São Borja), pursuant to Article 10-B of Law No. 11,445/2007. With this filing, the obligations present in the Federal Decree No. 10,710/2001 (“Decree”) have been met.

The Company informs that it has submitted to the agencies information on economic-financial indicators validated by independent auditors, as well as feasibility studies and fundraising plans that attest the economic-financial capacity for meeting the universalization goals in Article 11-B of Law 11,445/2007, validated by independent certifiers. This information is confidential due to its strategic nature to the Company’s business.

In addition, with the purpose of fulfilling Article 11, §2 of the Decree, Corsan will submit this information to the National Water and Sanitation Agency (ANA – Agência Nacional de Águas e Saneamento Básico), while preserving its confidentiality.

Albeit the Company’s fit with the concept of regionalization described in Bill 422/2021, approved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Rio Grande do Sul, and the legal authorization for privatization, present in State Law No. 15,708/2021, which would allow the Company to be presumed capable economically and financially, pursuant to Article 22 of the Decree, it has chosen to submit the Requirements as an additional form to promote greater legal security for the contracts signed with municipalities.

Corsan is responsible for the construction and operation of public drinking water supply and sewage services in the State of Rio Grande do Sul (RS). The Company operates in 317 of 497 municipalities and has 96.7% of universal access to drinking water in managed urban areas and 18% of universal access to sewage. Its scope reaches about six million people. Corsan also works by treating industrial effluents and solid residues from the III Petrochemical Complex, based in Triunfo (RS), as well as industrial effluents produced by the Industrial Motors Complex of General Motors do Brasil, in the city of Gravataí (RS). Corsan, headquartered in the city of Porto Alegre, is a mixed-capital company, whose share control is exercised by the State of Rio Grande do Sul.
