NOTICE TO THE MARKET

CORSAN SIGNS CONTRACT AMENDMENTS WITH 74 MUNICIPALITIES

Companhia Riograndense de Saneamento - Corsan (“**Company**”) announces that yesterday, 12/16/2021, ended the 90-day period granted by State Law No. 15,708/21 for the signing of contractual amendments. In total, 74 contracts were amended, including 9 out of the 10 largest municipalities served by Corsan. In return for their early commitment, these 74 municipalities will receive Company shares in the context of the intended privatization. These municipalities comprise approximately 52% of Corsan’s total revenue. With the recently signed amendments, the average term of contracts (weighted by revenue) is now 30 years.

The municipalities that signed amendments and extended the term of their contracts until 12/31/2062 are listed by revenue as follows: Canoas, Santa Maria, Gravataí, Passo Fundo, Rio Grande, Alvorada, Viamão, Cachoeirinha, Bento Gonçalves, Esteio, Santa Rosa, Tramandaí, Alegrete, Cruz Alta, Gramado, Montenegro, Vacaria, Imbé, São Borja, Sapiranga, Osório, Panambi, Dom Pedrito, Taquara, Estância Velha, Eldorado do Sul, Estrela, Rio Pardo, Santo Antônio Da Patrulha, Arroio Do Sal, São Jerônimo, Balneário Pinhal, Encruzilhada do Sul, Três Coroas, Nova Petrópolis, Nova Hartz, Tupanciretã, Júlio de Castilhos, Triunfo, Rolante, São José do Norte, Bom Retiro do Sul, Tenente Portela, Salto do Jacuí, Agudo, Palmares do Sul, Glorinha, Chapada, Faxinal do Soturno, General Câmara, Terra De Areia, Condor, Cambará do Sul, Barracão, Erval Seco, Pejuçara, Redentora, Mostardas, Mata, Dona Francisca, Santa Maria do Herval, Vila Nova do Sul, Aceguá, Paverama, Áurea, Marques de Souza, Inhacorá, Mariano Moro, Barão do Triunfo, Dilermando de Aguiar, Tavares, São José do Herval, Rio dos Índios and Itapuca.

Further to extending the contracts until 2062, the amendments also adapt the service to the changes brought by National Law No. 14,026/2020 (“**New Sanitation Bill**”) – establishing a detailed Action Plan for achieving universalization targets and quality in the provision of water and waste water services. The signed documents also include a [Tariff Annex](#), with proposals for best-practices in future fare revisions.

Contracts with municipalities that have not yet signed the amendments will remain valid under Art. 10, § 3 of the New Sanitation Bill, until the end of their terms.

The Company will remain open to the signing of contractual amendments with the remaining municipalities, with the purpose of complying with the provisions of Article 11-B, which determines the inclusion of universalization and quality targets for sanitation services until 03/31/2022. This corporate stance also include the adherence of municipalities to the proposal for fare revisions, according to which service fares would follow inflation (IPCA index) until 2026.

Corsan is responsible for the construction and operation of public drinking water supply and sewage services in the State of Rio Grande do Sul (RS). The Company operates in 317 of 497 municipalities and has 96.7% of universal access to drinking water in managed urban areas and 18% of universal access to sewage. Its scope reaches about six million people. Corsan also works by treating industrial effluents and solid residues from the III Petrochemical Complex, based in Triunfo (RS), as well as industrial effluents produced by the Industrial Motors Complex of General Motors do Brasil, in the city of Gravataí (RS). Corsan, headquartered in the city of Porto Alegre, is a mixed-capital company, whose share control is exercised by the State of Rio Grande do Sul.
